

# Bridgewater Junior/Senior High School Calculator Contract



Graphing calculators are an essential technological tool in today's math classroom and will be made available to Sr. High students (***on a first come first serve basis***) who agree to all terms and conditions by signing the given contract. As with textbooks, it is the responsibility of the guardian and student to ensure that the assigned calculator is returned in *proper working condition*. It is mandatory that both student and guardian read and sign this contract before the calculator will be loaned.

I, \_\_\_\_\_, Grade \_\_\_\_\_, agree to borrow and return the same TI graphing calculator provided to me by Bridgewater Junior Senior High School and agree to the following conditions:

- The calculator that has been loaned (in working condition) will either be returned in working condition or the replacement cost will be paid to the school:  
TI-83 = \$ 100.00    TI-84 plus = \$129.99
- Student responsibility includes damage due to misuse, carelessness, or loss.
- Students will provide batteries (at their own cost) and will be careful inserting batteries into the calculator; incorrect insertion may ruin the calculator by causing a solid blue screen that cannot be repaired.
- Students will be cautious of liquids and weather. Rain, snow, and drinks can destroy any electronic device; this includes calculators.
- Students will not put the calculator in a situation where the screen can crack. The plastic cover is strong but the screen can still break, even if covered.  
For example, do not place the calculator under heavy textbooks in a crowded backpack.
- Students will not store or import any games or store anything into the calculator's memory.
- Students will have the loaned calculator, or its replacement cost, at the final exam to be eligible to take the exam and will return the working calculator to their teacher at the conclusion of the exam.
